Frequently Asked Questions

How do I enroll my child?

Please pick up an application from the 21st CCLC Director, Mr. Saunders, in his office or the middle school main office. Fill out the form and have your child return it back to school.

How long are the programs? When are they held?

Mornings	7:00-8:30PM
Afternoons	4:15- 6:30PM
Saturdays	9:30-1:00PM

Can my child enroll in more than one activity or club?

Absolutely! It is encouraged that students enroll in more than one activity. Your child may be able to attend more than one activity in one day if his/her schedule allows or attend different activities on different days. Again, this depends on the advisement of what you would like your child to participate in and the weekly program schedule.

Does my child receive any snack? Transportation?

Yes, Snack is provided every day for any child that attends CCLC programs. Shuttle buses are provided during the week to major bus/train hubs. Saturday programs are provided with tokens for those students who attend that day. Tokens only apply for Saturdays.

How long do all these programs last?

The current programs will last until the end of the school year. Summer programming will be announced at the end of February 2011.

My child likes sports... Will you have athletic programs?

Yes. In the past, there have been tennis and golf programs. Maritime Academy Charter School does plan to implement some athletic and recreational programs for the summer.

I was not aware of any of this programming. How can I stay informed?

Announcements regarding all the programs are made each day at school to the student body. Flyers and club information are typically posted in the school or sent home with your child. Encourage your child to bring this literature to your attention.
