More Learning Opportunities in 2015

Since the first edition of *The MACHS Anchor*, there have been an incredible amount of learning opportunities for students related to the maritime industry. MACHS cadets have been privy to businesspeople, military personnel, and even institutions to learn about different nautical fields. Furthermore, many Philadelphia attractions also provided learning opportunities in 2014. This next year seems to provide even more maritime-related events for local residents. While areas like the Spruce Street Harbor, Schuylkill River Banks, and Navy Yard have already been featured in previous weeks, there are many other locations and events to detail these next few months. One such example is Venice Island, which was built in Manayunk as a recreational center and stormwater management system. Their involvement with the Philadelphia Water Department could offer science and art teachers worthwhile ideas for the classroom.

Another water-related location that hasn't been mentioned in our newsletter is Fairmount Water Works. Classes in the past have held field trips at the Water Works Museum, but for family and friends looking for free activities on the weekends, their calendar shows ongoing programs such as their Science Saturdays or Sunday Cinemas. During the month of January, visitors can learn about fish that survive the cold winter or watch *Ice Age: Meltdown*.

Finally, the much-anticipated maritime event of 2015 is sure to be Tall Ships Philadelphia-Camden. Tickets recently went on sale for tours and admissions taking place from June 25th to 28th. This is predicted to be the largest sailing event of the year in the United States, and will include vessels from countries like France and Brazil.
