A New Waterfront Park Set to Open along the Delaware River

Last year, we were excited to report about the openings of Spruce Street Harbor Park and a waterfront park located at the Washington Avenue Pier. This Thursday at 2:00 PM, **Mayor Michael Nutter** and the **Delaware River Waterfront Corporation (DRWC)** will officially open Pier 68. This is a \$1.7 million project that boasts of features such as a fishing point for locals to fish recreationally, a seating area and picnic grove to relax after a day of shopping at nearby stores, and an aquatic cut that allows for numerous observations related to the education of water elevations and habitats related to the Delaware River. Clearly, this is another location where South Philadelphia residents and interested visitors can enjoy!
