Thank you for your cooperation and support in our opening week of CLC. We experienced great interest in our programs. Please see changes listed below in red and a new offering in music. We have tried to honor the requests made by parents for programs. If we are unable to match students to specific programs due to the number of students who are interested, we have moved students into the academic enrichment programs on certain days.

Students are instructed to stay for CLC when the information on the application tells us that you, as parents, have asked them to stay on a particular day. If you do not want your child to stay as you originally requested, please send a note to your child's teacher or call the school office with this important information.

ALL students must be picked up by 6:30 PM.

Our 21st Century Community Learning Center is re-opening for the Fall on September 9th. Please review the programs available (Elementary School only) and complete the application form if your cadet is interested in joining. Students do not have to attend Maritime Academy to register for these programs. Please note that transportation is **NOT** available for both before and after school activities.

Music Appreciation: This program will expose students to various types of music. Students will listen to and sing songs from a variety of composers. Students who are already enrolled in CLC may express interest in this program at their next CLC session.

Meets from 4:00 to 6:30 PM according to the following schedule:

Tuesdays – Grades 1 to 3 Wednesdays – Grades 4 to 6 Thursdays – Grades 7 to 8

PSSA and More Morning Assistance: Our program is a technology integrated tutoring program that uses specialized instruction to help reach individual learners. Each student will have access to hands-on activities, Mac book pros, small-group instruction, and individual attention in this CLC program. This is a great program to help students with concepts they have difficulty in, a project that needs more direction, computer access, homework help, PSSA practice, or whatever the school related instruction may be.

Meets Monday through Friday from 7:15 to 8:15 AM in the computer lab.

LEGO Robotics: Students will build a LEGO robot from a kit in order to complete this year's mission; more details to come on this program.

Because of the program requirements, LEGO robotics is offered for Grades 4 to 8 only.

Meets Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

Academic Enrichment: Students will work in a classroom setting with a Maritime teacher for assistance in areas of academic weakness or on the day's homework. We will have college students in the room assisting the teachers in the work. In this Year of Math, we strongly encourage students who have not scored proficient in Math to consider attending these sessions.

Meets every Monday through Thursday from 4:00 to 6:30 PM

<u>Maritime PALS:</u> Older cadets will be matched up with younger cadets to assist them in various activities such as sports, problem-solving games, and homework. This program meets on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. This program can also provide service hours for 8thgraders who may need them for entering high school.

Meets Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

<u>News Reporters:</u> Cadets will do research on current events and report on upcoming/past events within the Maritime community. This program is open to 5^{th} through 8^{th} graders.

Meets on Mondays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

Boat Building: Cadets will work together to build a 12' long wooden boat that they will take out on the water at the end of the program. Under the guidance of a professional boat builder, students will learn and practice shop safety, reading plans, working safely with tools, construction techniques, and more. This program is open to 5-8 grade.

Dates to be determined.

Sailing: This program is open to 3rd to 8th graders that know how to swim.

The number of participants for each grouping is limited. Those students who have expressed interest in sailing are on the waiting list for the next section.

The program runs select Fridays from 4:00 to 7:00pm in the fall and the spring.

Art Program: This program is for 2nd grade to 8th graders. Cadets explore different modalities of artistic expression.

Meets Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

Strategic Applications: This strategy-based program focuses on the use of logic, planning, and analysis to develop higher-level thinking skills. Cadets will apply these higher-level thinking skills on logic puzzles, games, and strategic word problems. Programs is offered to students in Grades 1 to 8 in two grouping, Gr. 1 to 3 and Grades 4 to 8.

Because of a scheduling conflict, Strategic Applications will begin on Monday, October 28, 2019.

Grades 1 to 3 meets on Mondays and Tuesdays. Grades 4 to 8 meets on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

<u>Nutritional Awareness:</u> Cadets will develop awareness of good nutrition through hands-on study of food. Cadets will work to develop and cook healthy menus and encourage good eating habits.

Meets on Tuesdays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

Botany (Gardening): Cadets will study the world of plants with hands-on care. Classroom learning will be taken to the garden as the cadets work with plants and flowers.

Meets Tuesdays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

<u>Creative Writing:</u> Cadets will practice their creative writing, editing, and publishing skills as they work to create a literary magazine for our school.

Meets Mondays and Tuesdays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

<u>Sea Cadets</u>: This junior cadet program introduces its members to naval life through instruction in basic seamanship and leadership. Cadets are invited to sign up but must demonstrate a commitment to the program.

Meets Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:00 to 6:30 PM.

<u>Graphic Designs</u>: This program will use math and science to design unique products. Students will design and create individual and group crafts. This program is open to cadets in Grades 5 to 8.
