



New Arrival and Dismissal Procedures at the Frankford Arsenal for Maritime Cadets

Maritime families; during a meeting today with Arsenal management and Franklintonne's administration the following procedures were put in place for cadet drop off and pick up at the Arsenal. These procedures are effective immediately.

- **Cadets in kindergarten & 1st Grade:** drivers should enter using the Bridge Street entrance. They will turn right into the visitor's lot & then turn left using the **second** section of the visitor's lot. Students will then be dropped off at the **back** of building 106.
- **Cadets in grades 2 thru 6:** drivers should enter using the Bridge Street entrance. They will turn right into the visitor's lot and then turn left using the first section of the visitor's lot. Students will be dropped off by the guard shack and will cross the street and enter the Arsenal via the gate next to the turnstile. Parents wishing to walk their child into the Arsenal can park in the visitor's lot and walk through the same gate, next to the turnstile.
- **Cadets in 7th & 8th Grade:** Drivers should enter via the Tacony street entrance. They will make an immediate right turn and loop around the parking lot. Cadets should then be dropped in front of building 38 and they will be let through the turnstile next to the guard shack. Cadets should **not** be dropped off at the open gate at the back of the Tacony Street lot where Franklintonne students enter.
- If you have children that need to go to both drop off areas you can either drop all of your children off in the Bridge Street lot and have older cadets walk over to buildings 41 & 42 or you can drop the cadets in each lot, which would require you to drive from one visitor's lot to the other.
- You will follow the same procedures at both sites for dismissal.

- We are still closing our doors for arrival at 7:45 AM so please plan accordingly.
- For those that are granted access to the arsenal you can only park in designated parking areas or parking spots. You can not park in front of buildings 11, 106, 107 or any other area without designated parking spots.

As mentioned in a previous alert; the limiting of traffic into the Arsenal has been initiated by Arsenal management and not by Maritime. However, as tenants, we must abide by the policies and procedures of the Arsenal and their Condo Association. As these procedures begin it is very important that everyone stays patient and remembers that the safety of our cadets is what is most important.
