## **SUMMER VISIONS 2020 FACT SHEET**

We are looking forward to having another exciting and fun-filled summer with all of our cadets. To ensure a smooth start to our Summer Visions 2020 and Summer school programs for our Grades 1 to 8 cadets, we wanted to share these important facts with you.

- Our summer program operates Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
- Programming for Grades 1 to 4 will be held in Building 107. Programming for Grades 5 through 12 will be held remotely.
- The program begins on Monday July 1<sup>st</sup> and runs through August 12<sup>th</sup>. The school will be closed on July 3, 2020, but will be open all other weekdays during this period.
- Cadets will be permitted to enter the building at 8:45 AM daily; prior to 8:45 AM cadets will need to stay in the east yard (Located to the right when facing the front of the building) and will not be monitored by school staff. Cadets should practice social distancing. We recommend parents remain with their children until the east fire tower door opens and cadets report to the cafeteria.
- To keep with social distancing guidelines, only cadets may enter the building at arrival and dismissal. Cadets and staff will have their temperature taken at arrival. Anyone with a temperature above 99.4 °F will be excluded from participation. Exclusion from participation may be at the start of the day or at any other time that a person's temperature is above 99.4°F.
- Breakfast will begin to be served at 8:45 AM and lunch will be served at 11:30 AM daily. All meals are free of charge.
- Our day will be divided into two sessions: the morning will be dedicated to academics only (Mathematics & Language Arts), the afternoons will consist of a variety of enrichment and elective programs.
- **Summer School students only**- Cadets enrolled in summer school **must** attend the morning session daily. The state requires a set number of hours of instruction for summer school, therefore, attendance is mandatory. Summer school participants that do not meet the hour requirement will fail the class and will be retained in their current grade. A student that is mandated to attend summer school may participate in the afternoon session but those hours do not count as instructional time.
- Cadets that are being dismissed early must be signed out in the main office in building 11. Parents are not to report to the school (Building 107) until they have signed out their child and been given the clearance to walk to building 107 to retrieve their child. Children will be escorted to the middle doors of building 107 to meet their parent. Please recognize that it may take a few minutes for the main office staff to locate your child and get them escorted to the front of the building, so you should plan accordingly.

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- The security service at The Arsenal requests that parents park in the visitor lot inside the Bridge Street gate and walk your child to Building 107 at arrival and do the same for pick up. If you choose to enter The Arsenal through the Tacony St. entrance, please do not park outside Building 107 for drop off or pick up of cadets.
- Dismissal Procedures are as follows:
  - Non-Inclement weather - Cadets will be dismissed from the East yard (the same yard used for drop off in the morning. For safety and security we need to record when your child has left the premises so please inform a staff member when picking up your child from the yard.
  - Inclement weather - Cadets will still be dismissed from the East yard door. We will bring one classroom at a time to the doorway and send cadets to waiting parents. Unfortunately, we are unable to bring parents into the school building for dismissal.
- An Open House is under consideration and will be announced as we evaluate safety considerations. More details to follow.

## IMPORTANT NOTE

If for any reason, whether directed by the city or the state or by circumstances in our school, we must reserve the right to return to remote only activities for the safety of our cadets and staff. Any change to our scheduled programming will be communicated to participants and their families.



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
