Dear Maritime Families,

As we write this letter, we are finalizing plans for our traditional 21st Century Nita M. Lowey summer CLC programming. We will be hosting a six-week summer program for both our Summer School cadets and those wanting Summer Enrichment activities. We will have a limited number of spots in each grade for Summer Enrichment activities. Cadets required to attend summer school will automatically be given a spot in the program.

Our traditional summer program is open to students entering Grades K to 8. We limit the number of participants to no more than 25 students in each grade. Summer program is held Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM through 3:00 PM according to the following schedule:

Elementary School: Wednesday, June 29 - Wednesday, August 10 (no program on Monday, July 4)

For the elementary school, the day consists of two components. The morning session is split between academic enrichment in RELA and Math. The afternoon session has opportunities for further enrichment. Since there has been a significant learning loss for many cadets as a result of COVID across the country, we will focus on academics more strongly this summer than in previous years.

Applications are being distributed to all cadets and posted on our website.

Applications will be received according to a first come, first served basis after our Summer School cadets have been enrolled. We aim to allow maximum participation, but may not be able to meet all requests for participation in summer programming. Please complete the entire application and return it to the main office, Building 11. The quicker you return the application, the more likely your child will be to get a spot in the program.

This great program is <u>free</u> to participants so it is a great opportunity to fight the summer brain drain and to allow your child to better prepare for next school year. Be aware that unfortunately there is no bus transportation available for the summer program.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will summer programming follow any COVID guidelines?

A: Our summer CLC program will follow the most current CDC guidelines as it connects to social distancing, masks, etc. The school may also add additional guidelines as needed for local circumstances.

Q: My child currently attends Maritime Academy Charter School and is in good academic standing. Which program should I enroll him/her in?

A: Your child is the perfect candidate for the Summer Adventures program where he/she will receive academic lessons each day with an enrichment component in the afternoons. Remember, that we must focus our admission to the program this year on our cadets needing summer school.

Q: My child is in high school and has to attend summer school. Does he/she have to participate in the afternoon recreational activities?
