Attention Parents/Guardians and Cadets:

Our Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Center is re-opening for the Fall on September 6, 2022. These programs are the before school and after school programs for our school. Please review the programs available (Elementary School only) and complete the application form if your cadet is interested in joining. High School programs will be communicated by individual teachers coordinating the programs. Please note that transportation is **NOT** available for both before and after school activities.

CLC after-school programs begin right after dismissal. Parents should go to the main office in Building 11 to sign out their child. CLC staff will bring the cadet to the front doors of Building 107 for dismissal. We use the same dismissal information provided on your child's school application. Please contact the school office if there is any change to your pick-up plan to avoid delays at the sign-out process.

At the Elementary School, all participants must be picked up no later than 5:30 PM.

On the application form, please indicate which days you wish your child will attend and for which programs you would like them to participate in each day. **IMPORTANT:** Based on staffing and class size, we cannot guarantee that your child will be rostered in the requested class each time they attend. The cadets, however, will be able to participate in our CLC program, but may be shifted to another program.

We plan for CLC programs based on the applications received. We will assume that you child is staying for CLC on the days listed on the application you fill out unless you contact us to tell us otherwise.

CLC participants at the Elementary School will receive a snack at the beginning of classes. All cadets will do Homework Help at the beginning of their CLC class no matter which class they are assigned.

As in the past, program may be added or deleted as staffing changes throughout the year. Our current grants ask programs to reflect an emphasis on Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.

Program Offerings at the Elementary School:

PSSA and More Morning Assistance: Our program is a technology integrated tutoring program that uses specialized instruction to help reach individual learners. Each student will use their Chromebook to work on assigned programs or receive individual help. This is a great program to help students with concepts they have difficulty in, a project that needs more direction, computer access, homework help, PSSA practice, or whatever the school related instruction may be.

Meets Monday through Friday from 6:30 to 7:15 AM in various locations for all grades.

Academic Enrichment: Students will work in a classroom setting with a Maritime teacher for assistance in areas of academic weakness or on the day's homework. We will have tutors available in the room assisting the teachers in the work.

Meets every Monday through Thursday from 3:00 to 5:30 PM for all grades.

Book Club: Cadets in Grades 5 to 8 are invited to share their love of reading.

Meets Wednesdays from 3:00 to 5:30 PM. Programs begins in October.

League Cadets: This junior cadet program introduces its members to naval life through instruction in basic seamanship and leadership. Cadets are invited to sign up but must demonstrate a commitment to the program.

Meets Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00 to 5:30 PM for cadets age 11 – 14.

Lego Connections: Through the use of Legos, cadets will learn about science and engineering.

Meets on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for cadets in Grades 3 through 8.

Maritime Pals: This mentoring program is designed to pair younger cadets with our upper classmates to explore good citizenship, fun, and sportsmanship.

Meets Monday through Thursday for cadets in Grades Kindergarten, 1, and 2.

Lil' Scientists: This program is designed to introduce basic science topics in a fun and hands-on way for our cadets.

Meets Mondays and Wednesdays for cadets in Grades Kindergarten, 1 and 2.

Science Adventures: Cadets will explore science topics and get some hands on experience with these topics.

Meets Wednesdays and Thursdays for cadets in Grades 5 through 8.

Writing Spotlight: The main focus of this activity will be direct work on the school yearbook. Other writing opportunities will be added as the year progresses.

Meets Wednesdays for cadets in Grade 7 and 8.
