Volleyball season is underway! Congratulations to all of our cadets who made the team this year!

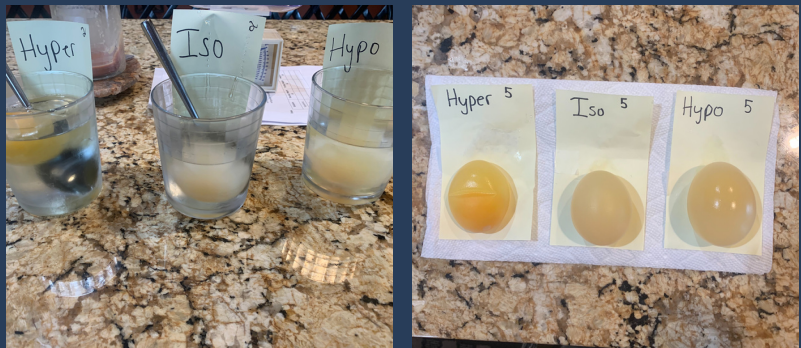


## High School Events in Pictures
