



A group of Cadets visited the Fairmount Water Works on 10/18. Cadets participated in the "We Drink the River" program by touring the Philadelphia Water Works, and learning about the water supply system history, river health, and urban watershed issues.

Cadets collected water samples to test for river health parameters, including dissolved oxygen, pH, nitrates, and phosphates. Cadets collected plankton, then identified the plankton using microscopes attached to iPads.


After our time in the lab, Cadets toured the Mussel Hatchery to make the connection to the research the Philadelphia Water Department is doing on freshwater mussels.




